

**A Guide to Parallel Paragraph and Page References in Oxford
University Press Editions of Hume's *Enquiry concerning the Principles
of Morals***

This guide enables readers to locate in the recently published OUP editions of Hume's second *Enquiry* those section and paragraph numbers (the universal references) that correspond to the page numbers of the edition of this work that has in the past been widely cited in scholarly literature, namely, that first edited by L. A. Selby-Bigge in 1894 and revised by P. H. Nidditch in 1975 (SBN). The paragraphs designated in the right-hand columns **begin** on the SBN page designated in the left-hand columns. If a right-hand column is blank, no paragraph begins on the page designated in the left-hand column.
